## What is an Annual Parish Meeting?

Every English Parish must have a Parish Meeting (Local Government Act 1972, s13 (1)).

This meeting consists of the local government electors registered for the area for which it is held i.e. all those who have a right to vote in *Stoke Rochford and Easton*. It can be convened by the Parish Council Chairman, two Parish Councillors or six electors for the area for which it is to be held. The meeting must be held each year between 1st March and 1st June (incl.) and must be after 6pm in the evening!

It is an opportunity for the Parish Council and any organisations or charities within the village to report on their activities during the year.
